

Sport Programs

ELITE PERFORMER AND TALENTED ATHLETE PROGRAMS

Mackellar has many athletes who are participating at state, national and international levels of competition. As a community, we recognise the heavy demands sport at the elite level has on students, and we have support programs that offer students who qualify, the opportunity to:

- Develop lifestyle plans, which balance commitments in sport, work, school and leisure efficiently
- Access to qualified experts in fields of sports science, nutrition, psychology and medicine
- Negotiated curriculum according to student needs
- Liaison with teacher, student, parent and coach
- Specialist Elite Performer mentor group

INTEGRATED SPORT AND PDHPE FOR ALL STUDENTS IN YEARS 7 AND 8

Skill development and teamwork are promoted through participation in a variety of physical activities. This is done in a friendly, challenging and fun environment. Sports include games, dance, aquatics, lifesaving, gymnastics and recreation.

RECREATIONAL AND COMPETITIVE SPORT FOR YEARS 9 & 10

Students select a sport three times a year from the following

Students gain access to expert tuition at school or in the community whilst interacting with students from other years and schools.

EXTRACURRICULAR SPORTING OPPORTUNITIES

Sport which takes place outside the timetabled school lessons is called **extracurricular sport**. Mackellar is very proud of the strong participation record, variety and results achieved in this area of sport.

State Knockout Teams: Mackellar enters many teams in a variety of sports in the state-wide knockout competition, enjoying success in netball, waterpolo, swimming, touch football, softball, futsal, basketball, hockey, football, volleyball, cricket and tennis. Students from all years are eligible to try out for a team of their choice. Most sports are open divisions, however, touch football, netball, futsal and waterpolo have Under 15 carnivals as well.

Weekend and After-School teams: Mackellar staff are committed to distributing up-to-date information relating to community competitions for any other sports students may be interested in.

SPORTS LEADERSHIP

Sports administration and competition management: Elective Physical Activity & Sports Studies students are provided the opportunity to officiate at local primary school sports carnivals and sports competitions through the Premier Sporting Leadership Programs.

Gala Day Coaching and Umpiring: Physical Activity & Sports Studies students learn about coaching and umpiring principles and after being assigned to a Year 7 and 8 team, lead the team for planned practice sessions and gala day competition, and teaching students in local primary schools.

Sports Prefects, House Captains and House Leaders: Students from each year group per house take on the role of liaison between the sports staff and the students. Sports Prefects inform students of weekly sports notices every Wednesday at assembly.

RECOGNITION OF SPORTS ACHIEVEMENTS

Mackellar Girls recognises the achievements of students who participate in sport at every level. Students are recognised via the school newsletter, sports achievement board, local newspapers, school merit system, Wednesday assemblies and the Term 4 Sports Assembly.





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
