

First Point for Contact

We encourage students to build agency and make first contact with teachers. If you feel you need to make contact on your child's behalf, please use the table below so contact can be addressed appropriately.

You can email the school's email address and attention to the specific staff member or make a phone call.

When calling or emailing please provide the reason for contact as enquires that do not give a reason will not be able to be prioritised. We ask that you please be courteous, polite and respectful in line with the School Community Charter.

| Staff | Reason for Communication |
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| Class Teacher | Anything pertaining to the individual subject or class. This includes classwork, assessments, and general class enquiries. |
| Head Teacher | If a parent has worked with their child's classroom teacher and feels an issue requires further clarification or attention. |
| Year Advisers | Can assist with matters related to wellbeing or concerns with overall engagement. |
| Head Teacher Welfare | Can assist with matters related to wellbeing or health concerns that are serious in nature. The HT Welfare also leads the learning support faculty and can be approached if your child needs support due to individualised learning needs |
| Head Teacher Teaching & Learning | Coordinates the Academic and talent program. The HT T&L can assist with enquiries regarding High Potential and Gifted Education |
| Deputy Principal overseeing the student's year group | Can assist with general matters regarding curriculum and administration. |

Issues should first be directed to the relevant staff member who may then escalate to the senior executive if required. Appointments to see senior executive can be made through school administration.
